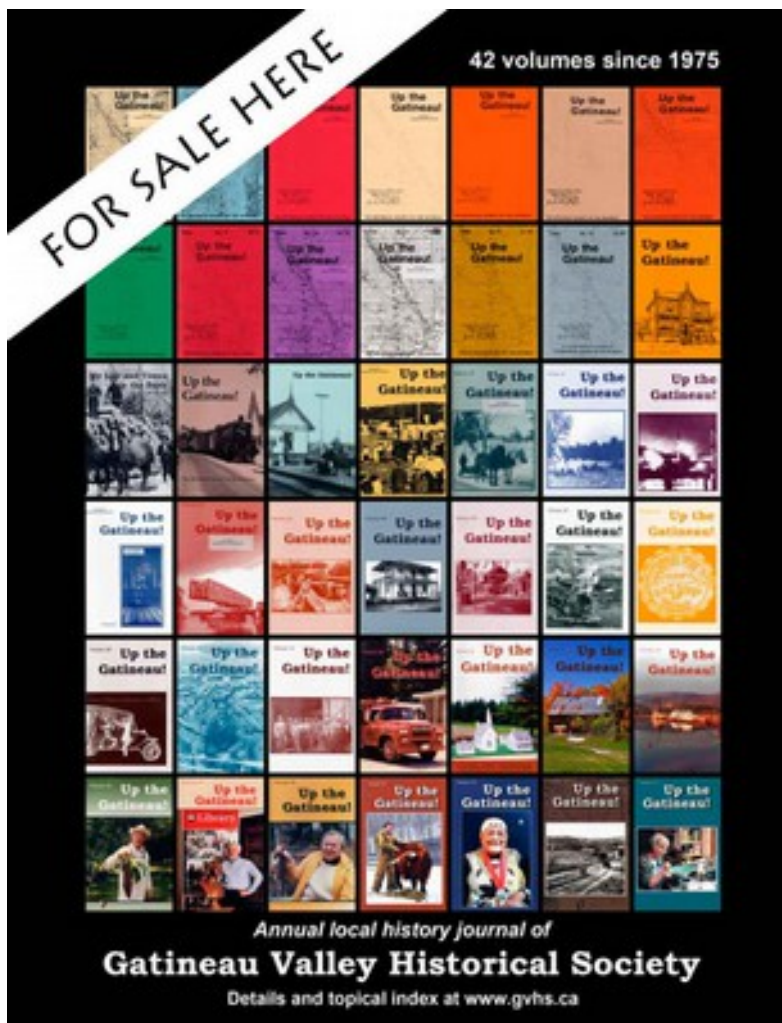

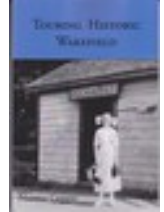

Touring Historic Wakefield

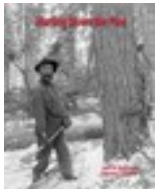
