SEASON MEMBERSHIP

In previous years use of the Club's facilities until January 1st. has been permitted to those holding membership badges from the preceding season. Last season's membership will not entitle you to use Club or Tow Company facilities this year and, to avoid the last minute rush and possible disappointment in the event of a delay in the pre-Christmas mail, you are advised to return your membership application to the Club now. CLOSURE OF ALEXANDER PARKING LOT

The Club's sole and entire jurisdiction to the Alexander parking lot has been challenged on a number of occasions, by persons claiming they had acquired through use, a right of access and use of the said lot by the simple passage of time. With a view to providing a clear basis of challenge to the Club's claim to such exclusive jurisdiction, it has been deemed advisable to interrupt any delays on which any such party has relied in the past and would presumably attempt to rely in future, to proceed as indicated by the use and enforcement of the following notice on December 5th, 1963.

"The Ottawa Ski Club hereby gives notice that use of the Alexander parking lot at Camp Fortune for parking or any other purpose, shall not be permitted on Thursday, December 5, 1963, starting at midnight for the following 24 hours. The only exceptions will be persons holding parking permits valid for that day or other persons specifically authorized in writing signed after November 15, 1963, by the representative of the Board of Directors of the Ottawa Ski Club who shall be specially authorized for this sole purpose."

"By Order of the Board of Directors"

In the event that the enforcement of the said prohibition would be considered prejudicial to a formal right granted in virtue of any specific agreement with the Club, the Club Directors are only too willing to authorize use of the said lot by a writing to that effect setting forth the extent of the right and its contractual basis, but excluding any other grounds for use of the lot than those set forth in the specific writing to be completed. The Directors would accordingly welcome an acknowledgment of having received these presents and any application for permission to use the said lot on the day in question and in this regard, would request that such application indicate the specific agreement being relied upon.
