CENTENNIAL INTERNATIONAL SKI JUMPING MEET  
CAMP FORTUNE - FEBRUARY 25-26, 1967

As its contribution to Canada's centennial year, the Ottawa Ski Club is host to an international ski jumping meet to be held at Camp Fortune on February 25-26. The following countries have confirmed that they will be sending at least two of their top jumpers.

Sweden	Japan	Czechoslovakia	United States
Russia	Austria	West Germany	

In addition Canada's National Team will compete, four members of which are from the O.S.C. The jumpers will compete for team Centennial trophies and individual medals will be awarded.

The Club's share of the cost of this meet will be almost \$30,000. Most of the Club's expenditures have been on capital improvements to the Club's jump - thus, providing the Club with greatly improved facilities of permanent value. Because this is a Club project, all members are being asked to purchase a badge and to promote the sale of badges and tickets to non-members. The pertinent facts are as follows:

Passport badges advance sale - \$2.00 (value \$4.00)

This badge provides a "Centennial Special" two day membership in the Club, and will permit the holder to enter Camp Fortune Ski areas, to obtain free parking and to watch the Jumping Competition. The holder may also purchase a lift ticket at reduced lift rates each day. (Season's lift passes for skiing will be honored to Passport badge holders only.)

Discount Date

Termination date of advance sale of Passport badges at \$2.00 is January 31, 1967. The price increases to \$3.00 February 1st to 19th and becomes \$4.00 February 20th to 26th.

General Admission-Ticket

For those who do not wish to purchase a Passport badge, a general admission ticket may be purchased at the gate at \$2.00 each day of the two day event to witness the Jumping Competition only. No special day membership or skiing privileges apply.

Children 12 and under (Juniors)

There is no charge for admission to the jumping meet - Regular day rates apply for skiing.

New Lockeberg Jump Specification

It has been constructed to full 60-meter Federation Internationale de Ski (FIS) standard and has been successfully christened by Pat Morris, Saturday, December 24, 1966. The old jump record of 212' was set by Gerry Gravelle in 1965 and the new record will likely be established at 235'.

**DAY MEMBERSHIP RATES**

The Board of Directors authorized changes in the day membership rates and guest privileges to be effective commencing the weekend of January 7, 1967. The objective of the Board in making these changes is to have day members pay their fair share of the cost of providing free parking (this formerly cost them 50¢) and their share of the increased cost of Club programs. Since annual members are already paying these costs as a result of the increased annual membership rates introduced last fall, and Board decided to exempt guests of members from the increased day rates and to provide more generous guest membership privileges. The day membership rates are as follows:

**Weekends and Holidays**

Non-Members, Senior and Intermediate	\$ 3.00
Guest of Senior and Intermediate members	\$ 1.00 (At Club Office Alexander Lodge)
Non-Member Juniors	\$ 1.00

**Week-days**

All categories	\$ 1.00

There is no limit to the number of guests a senior or intermediate member may introduce at the \$1.00 rate, however, the same guest may be introduced only once per season by the same member. In addition, each senior member is still entitled to have one free guest during the season. On weekends, guest memberships are available only at the Club Office in Alexander Lodge; the free guest membership may be obtained at Tow Company offices during the week.
